
SITE PLAN FOR INDIVIDUAL LOTS

Notes:

- Reduce sediment leaving your construction site by implementing Best Management Practices (BMPs)
 such as:
 - Limit mud track-out into private or public streets by parking on paved streets or driveways whenever possible. If necessary, utilize a temporary rock drive.
 - o Clean up any mud that has been tracked off the construction site with 48 hours.
 - o Implement sediment controls along the lower sides of the property to protect adjacent waterways, storm drains, public ROW and neighboring property from sedimentation.
 - Keep a clean site. Dispose of construction waste materials and debris in a dumpster or containment device. Store all hazardous materials indoors.
 - o Portable toilet must be stacked and anchored away from any storm drain inlets.
 - Inspect your site bi-weekly and after rain events to find any potential problems and keep your
 Best Management Practices repaired and in good working order.
